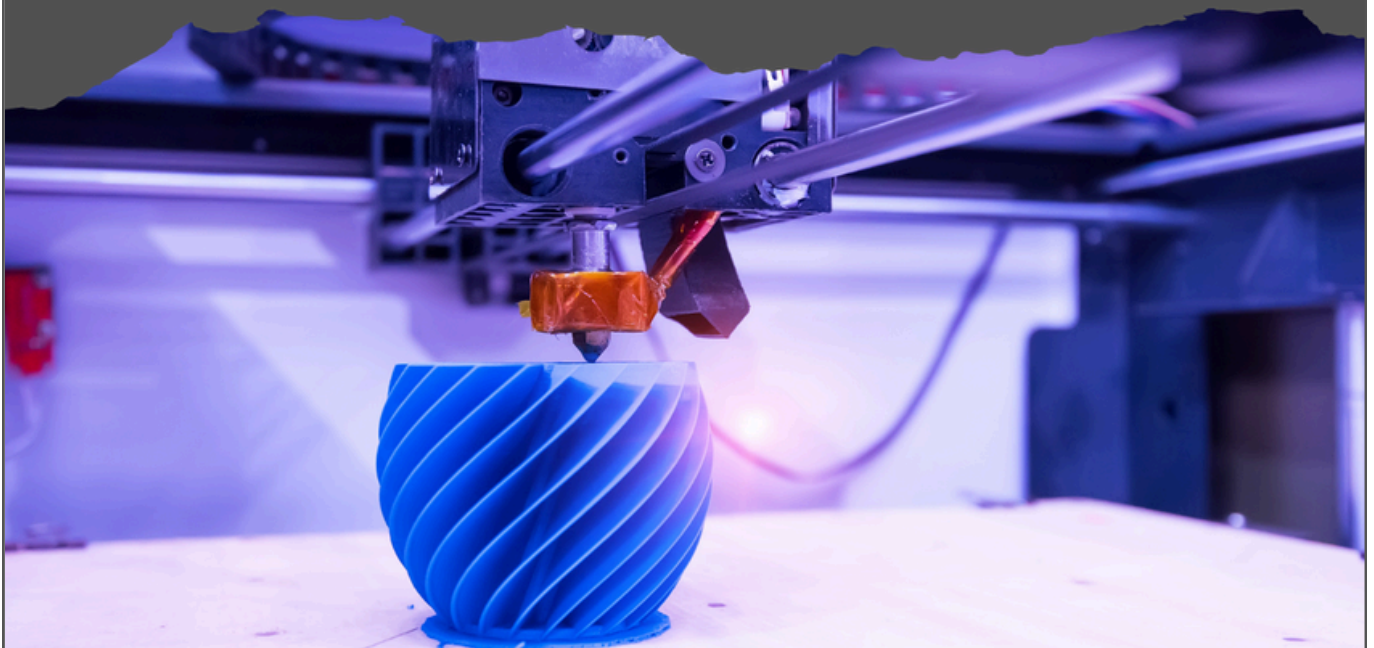

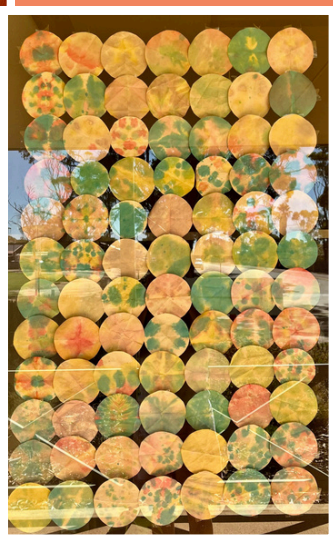


Events Recap
